



What is Service-Learning?

Service-Learning is a philosophy of teaching and learning that combines meaningful community service with academic learning, personal growth, and civic responsibility for positive community change. This instructional methodology places dual emphasis on service and learning. Effective Service-Learning will:

- Be organized in relation to an academic course or curriculum
- Have clearly stated learning objectives
- Address real community needs in a sustained manner over a period of time
- Allow students to regularly reflect on their learning through organized reflection or critical analysis activities such as classroom discussions, presentations, or directed writing
